## General Questions and Answers

- **Is there a participation cost?** There are no participation costs for any PACT productions. PACT is responsible for production costs including costumes and sets.
- **Who can be in the cast?** All interested students are invited to audition. The only requirement is attending all schedule rehearsals and performances. Any exceptions must be cleared with the director in advance of rehearsals.
- **When and where are the rehearsals?** Rehearsals are held Tuesday - Friday after school until 6pm in the multi-purpose room. Tech rehearsals will be held Saturday April 3, and Monday - Wednesday, April 5 - 7. These rehearsals will end no later than 6:30pm.  
***There can be no conflicts with the rehearsal schedule Tuesday, March 30 through Wednesday, April 7.***
- **Can my child crew?** Yes! The backstage crew is a vital part of the production. Serving on the crew is a great way to participate, especially if the rehearsal schedule conflicts with other commitments. At a minimum, crew members are required to attend all Tech Week rehearsals.
- **How much are tickets?** Tickets are \$5 for children and \$10 for adults.
